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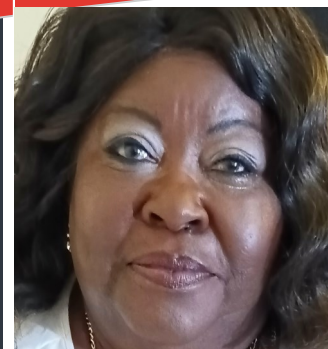

What have you been thinking lately? Are you thinking about your circumstances and your troubles? Do you fear the future, are you concern about what will happen to all of your future plans? Every one of us from time to time has concerns about the unknown of the future. But as Christians God has promised us a great victory and a wonderful future. In Jeremiah 29:11 the word of God say “*For I Know the plans I have for you declares the Lord, plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you a hope and a future.*” God is always planning the best for his children. God, by his power preserve the world he created. In Nehemiah 9:6 it says “*You alone are the Lord. You give life to everything, and all the multitudes of heaven worship you.*” In Psalm 36:6-7 it says “*Your righteousness is like the mighty mountains, your justice like the great deep. O Lord you preserve both man and beast. How priceless is your unfailing love.*” The preserving power of God is accomplished through His Son Jesus Christ. In Colossians 1:17 it says “*He is before all things and in him all things hold together.*” Christ is before all things and by him all thing consist. y The word “consist” means to put together, to hold together by power and authority, to hold together even in the smallest details. Even the smallest details of your life are held together God’s word.

What God preserves he also provides for. God provides for the needs of his people. God is a God of provision. Provision is a covenant promise for the children of God. In Psalms 103:1-5 it says, “*Praise the Lord, O my soul; and all my inmost being, praise his holy name. Praise the Lord, O my soul, and forget not all his benefits, who forgives all your sins and heals all your diseases, who redeems your life from the pit and crowns you with love and compassion, who satisfies your desires with good things so that your youth is renewed like the eagle.*” In Psalm 104:10-15 it also says, “*He makes springs pour water into the ravines; it flows between the mountains. They give water to all the beast of the field; the wild donkeys quench their thirst. The birds of the air nest by the waters; they sing among the branches. He waters the mountains from his upper chambers; the earth is satisfied by the fruit of his work.*

The word immediately registered in my mind as a choice of defeat. My mind and body began to reject the word. Acceptance, I imagined was me accepting my horrible life for what it is. As I got up to leave Doctor... office she told me to think about it. I told her I would, and I did. I went back to my housing unit, and I pondered on the idea. Has resistance all my life, to my life, my circumstance and my poor choices been the reason for all my pain and suffering? I thought to myself. That night I took my thoughts to be with me and I slept on it. The next day I was sitting at the dayroom table thinking about y my life and the idea of acceptance. Then I started reading a few religious newsletters. One of them was yours. The Winter 2022 edition sat in my possession, and I read it, along with the others. Suddenly a feeling came over me and tears burst from the corner of my eyes. The first impression I received ass the tears poured down my face was the word “Acceptance”. I immediately realized what was happening. God was speaking to me through people, places, and things. He wanted me to accept him into my life. He wanted me to practice Acceptance of his Love and Glory. Thank you, Son Reign Prison Ministry and Minister Wilson, for participating as a catalyst towards my acceptance of God in my life.
